Checklist

1) Abstract, to include the following:

- Submit an abstract in a WORD document
- 3-5 learner objectives
- Brief outline/agenda of the specific points to be covered during the program
- Why this program should be added to the schedule
- Brief program description to promote the program in marketing materials

Please keep in mind the World Congress is a Continuing Medical Education Event where AMA PRA Category / Credit will be issued. The content or format of a CME activity or its related materials must promote improvement or quality in healthcare and not a specific proprietary business interest of a commercial interest. All presentations must give a balanced view of therapeutic options. Use of generic names will contribute to this impartiality. Your presentation cannot contain any advertising, trade name or a product-group message.

2) Main Author/Speaker Biography

A document describing the presenting author's experience, qualifications, clinical and/or research pursuits. (50 words max.)

3) Digital Photo

Supply in a JPEG or TIFF format, a high-resolution color headshot of the main author/presenter (minimum 300 dpi) Attach to the submission email.

4) Completed disclosure statement

ALL authors listed on the abstract are required to complete a financial disclosure statement for the abstract submission, either disclosing all financial relationships and commercial interests of each author or indicating that none exists.
